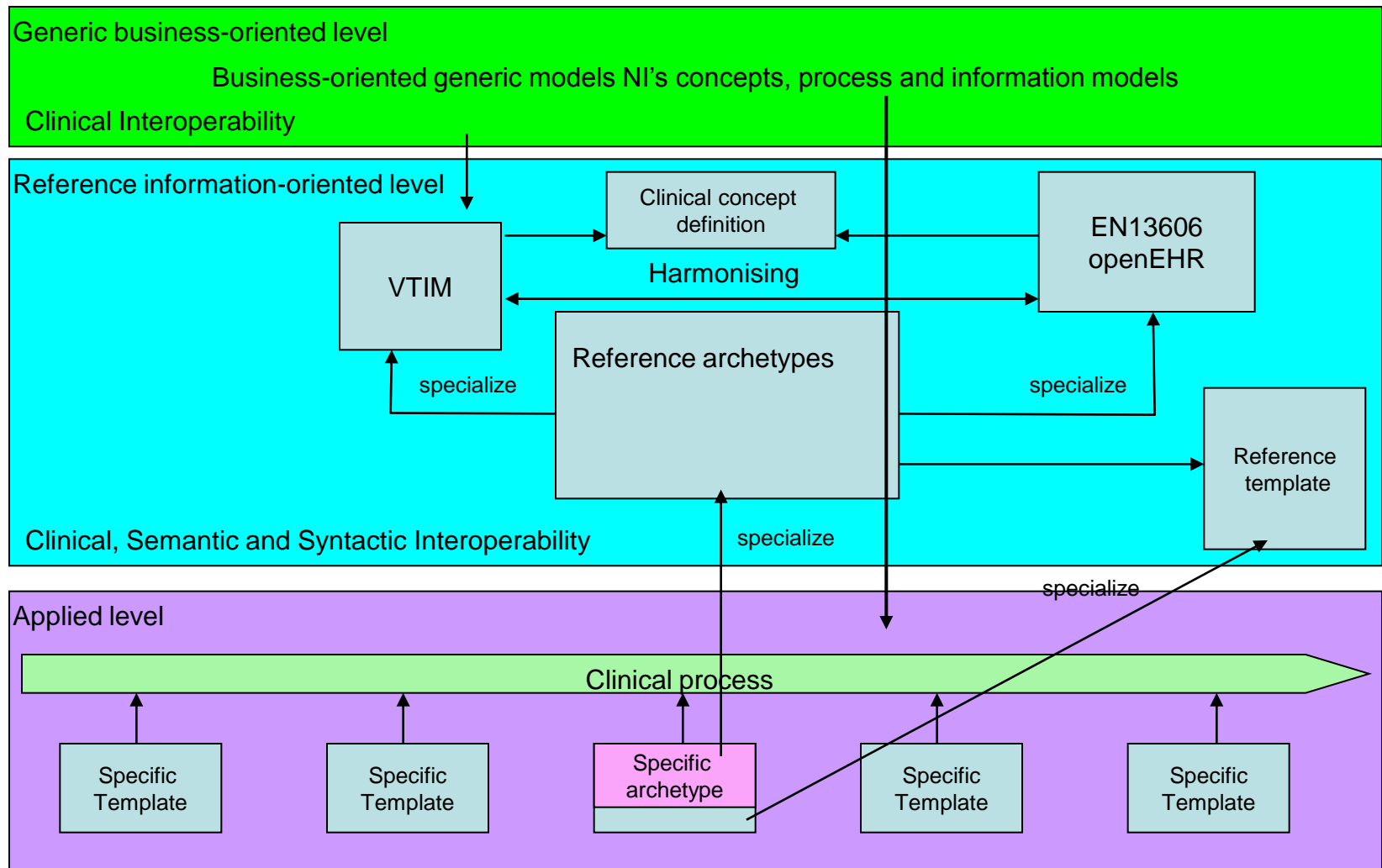

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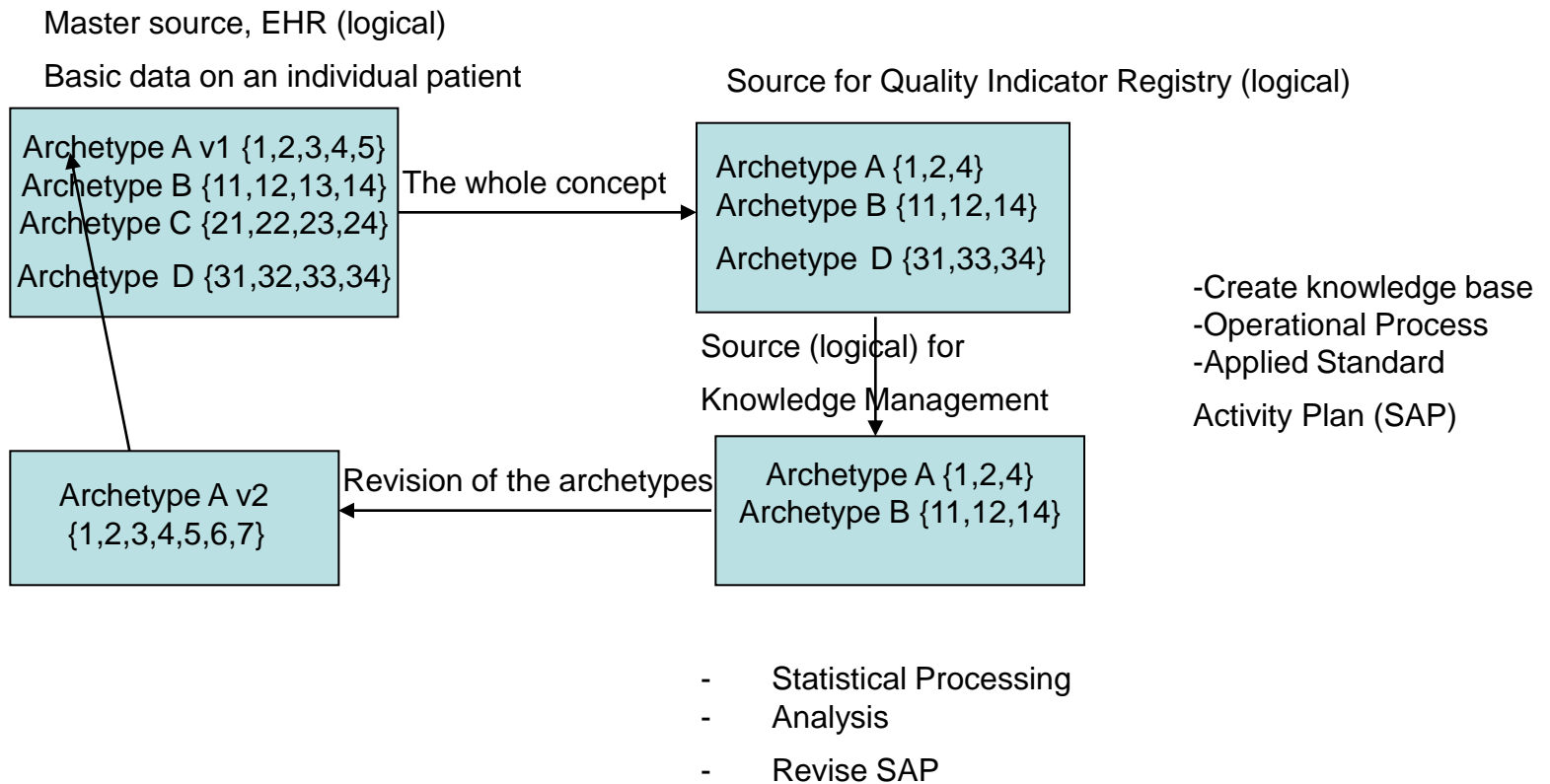
...but business process and information models

insufficient as a basis for building archetypes

Following perspectives on information management should be considered

- Documentation (EHR) - to document what is important to know in the particular clinical process for one patient
- Quality indicator registers - to monitor the progress of groups of patients who have the same kind of health problems and thus follows the same type of clinical process.
- Knowledge Management (Standardised activity plans) - to provide knowledge about what is the best way to provide care for patients with this type of health problems.
- Management, Logistics inc. Resource Management should be derivable from the stored amounts of information
